INTRODUCTION - Low level laser therapy can benefit almost every aspect of a dental practice. Applications such as dental analgesia, treatment of dentin hypersensitivity, healing of soft tissue lesions, reduction of pain and swelling after surgical procedures, better integration of implants into bone and faster movement of teeth during orthodontic procedures are commonly performed and researched procedures. Clinically, LLLT can be used with easy in a dental clinic; because laser therapy is non-invasive and has no significant side effects, the treatments can be performed by the dental auxiliary staff and integrated into the practice with very basic training.
